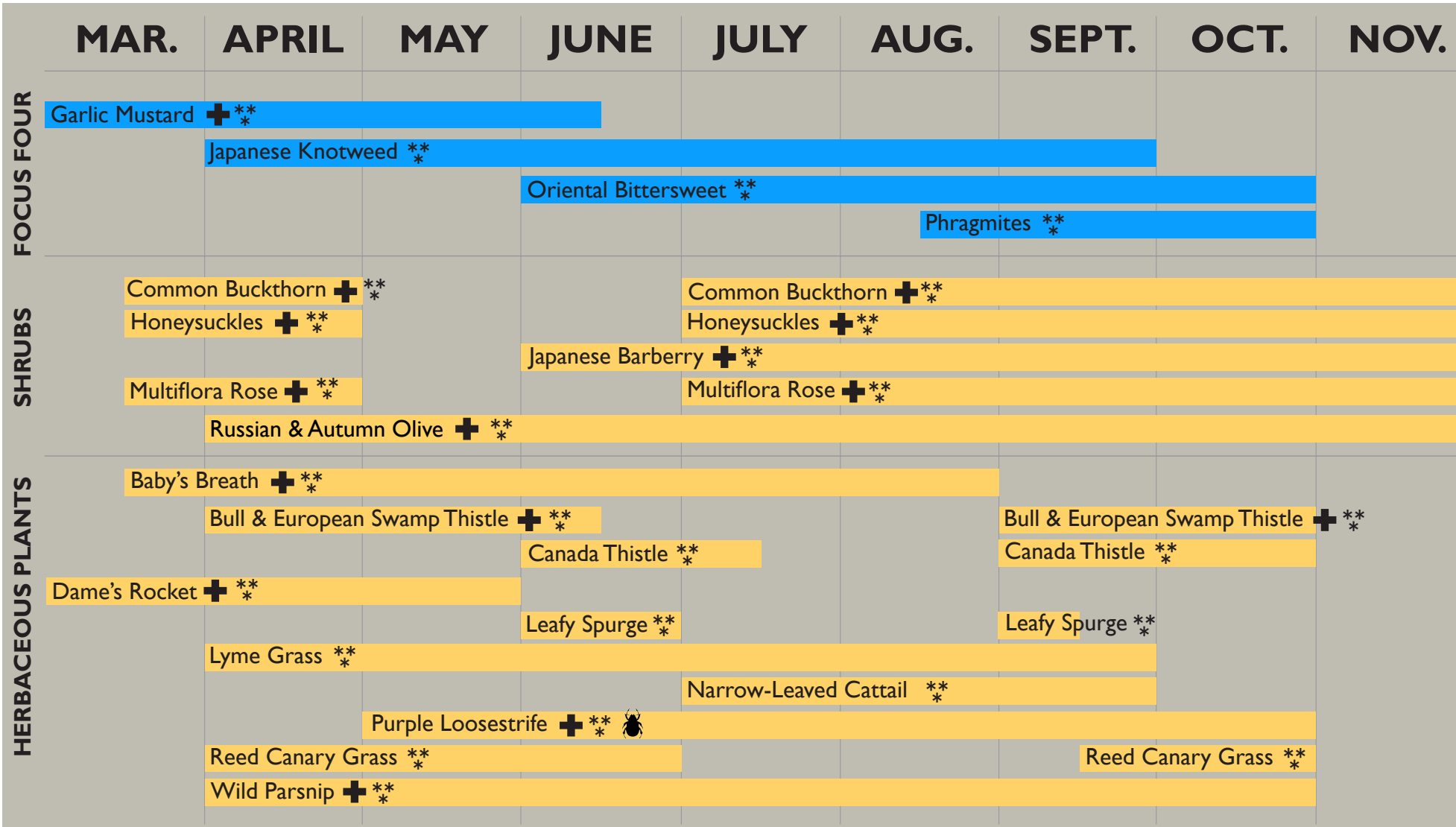


Northwest Michigan Invasive Species Treatment Times

ABOUT THIS CHART: Northwest Michigan Invasive Species Network protects our region through terrestrial invasive plant management. We concentrate our efforts on the Top 20 Least Wanted Species, which includes what we call the Focus Four – plants that pose the greatest threat to high-quality natural areas.
